Vintage coffee pots may have outlived their utility, but they sure haven't lost their looks. Contributor Zack Barowitz shows us how these relics—with their decorative details and elegant tapered forms—can be easily repurposed into curvaceous carafes or vases. Pop off the handle and rim by removing the screws that connect them at the top of the glass. Or, if necessary, use a Dremel to carefully bore out any screw bolts.
